when to use and how to apply

Broken and grazed skin areas

Cover the damaged skin area with a visible coating of ANIWELL FiltaBac Cream. This will naturally replace the lost skin and act as an anti-bacterial cover. Re-applying ANIWELL FiltaBac Cream to the area daily without removing the original cover. After 3 or 4 days, gently remove the ANIWELL FiltaBac Cream from the area by using warm water and a mild soap or antiseptic solution. Pat dry and re-apply ANIWELL FiltaBac Cream. This area will form new skin and should be clear in 7 to 10 days. Hair re-grows naturally on the area.

Girth Galls and Girth Rub

The broken skin areas should be dealt with as above (Broken and Grazed Skin Areas). The Galls will not directly benefit from the external application of ANIWELL FiltaBac Cream, but once the pressure is applied and the skin becomes inflamed then a thick film should be applied to the inflamed area. If the girth has to be applied, do not remove the ANIWELL FiltaBac Cream cover.

Bites, Cuts and Gashes

Frequently the skin will be broken, the area bruised and it will swell. Fill the broken area with ANIWELL FiltaBac Cream. If the broken skin requires stitching, then consult your Veterinary Professional. If professional help will be delayed, a cover application of ANIWELL FiltaBac Cream will maintain the wound and NOT impede the suturing and can remain in a wound after suturing.

Fly and Insect worry (on damaged skin areas)

A good visible cover on any area likely to be worried...flies and insects don't like ANIWELL FiltaBac Cream!

Mud Fever

Mud Fever requires treatment by your Veterinary Professional and their advice should be followed. Any treatment administered by your Veterinary Professional may be liberally covered by ANIWELL FiltaBac Cream so as to form a protective, totally natural second skin.

Other situations and conditions for using ANIWELL FiltaBac

Bit pressure and mouth damage, rain scald causing flaky and irritated skin, saddle pressure areas, sun screen protection and sunburn soothing.
